1- Global Mission

Global Mission is the name of the Christian organization that started this christian school project in Burkina Faso. Global Mission itself is a branch of (**The Return of the King Fellowship**), a larger Christian NGO based in California. Rev. Dr. Joshua Park is the President of both Organizations. I, Pawendtare Kombassere, am the local representative of Global Mission in Burkina Faso. I met Dr. Park in 2013, on a divine appointment, in the USA, while studying at Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary. Since then, it has been my delight to cooperate with him to spread God's love and the good news of Jesus Christ, in my part of the world.

2- Evangelical High School of Tiogo

The Evangelical High School of Tiogo is the fruit of my cooperation with Dr. Park. The school is committed to provide a solid Christian education to middle and high school students in the village of Tiogo and to those from surrounding villages. With a low literacy rate, coupled with many challenges in its educational system, one of Burkina Faso's real needs is a sound education for the youth. We firmly believe that a quality education incorporates biblical values and is foundational to raising responsible and productive citizens.

3- Infrastructures

With God's help and thanks to the vision of the man of God, Dr. Joshua Park and his ministry partners, the following infrastructures were built and the school opened its doors in October 2015:

- 1- A four-classroom building
- 2- An office building
- 3- A well with a hand pump
- 4- Toilets

4- The Evangelical Aspect

In addition to providing good education to the vouth, we also aim to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with our students and the populations around the school. Jesus said in John 14:6 : "I am the way, the truth and the life: no one comes to the Father but through me." Further on, in 1 Corinthians 10:20 the Bible explains that "What pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons." Thus, in a country where many still sacrifice animals to idols in desperate search for peace, we are not ashamed to proclaim the Good News that Jesus is the prince of peace. In the course of the academic year 2015-2016, we distributed new Bibles to all of our students who gladly received them. We open every class with prayer and use biblical wisdom in all we do. In addition to the regular courses, we also offer 2 hours of Bible classes weekly to our students. As a result, 17 students out of a total of 43 accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior of their lives. They are being discipled and are encouraged to attend a Bible-based church in the village.

- A solar panel project for lighting and office work

- Sponsoring students in need

- Four additional classrooms will be needed (by September 2017)
- A library
- A chapel for worship and discipleship for students and community
- A solar-powered pump for running water and growing food
- An apartment building for staff
